



Eliot Elementary students are required to wear school uniforms.

- ❖ Polo or Oxford Type Shirts or Polo collar dresses- classic red, navy blue, purple, or white (long or short sleeve)
- ❖ Any logo on **any** item should be smaller than a quarter
- ❖ Leggings in solid uniform colors may be worn under skirts and shorts
- ❖ Socks must be solid uniform colors or black (logos smaller than a quarter)
- ❖ Sweatshirts/Sweaters worn over collared uniform shirts in class - Eliot sweatshirt, plain sweatshirts/sweaters (classic red, navy blue, purple, white)
- ❖ Slacks, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, dresses and capris (TPS standard length guidelines) in khaki and navy
- ❖ Shoes - closed toe
- ❖ Long-sleeved shirts worn under uniform shirts must be uniform colors - classic red, navy blue, purple, white
- ❖ **Items not allowed** - printed tights/socks, open-toed sandals, flip flops, vests, undershirts showing below hemline, t-shirts not in solid uniform colors worn under collared uniform shirt and leggings worn as slacks.

SPIRIT DAYS Last day of the school week - Eliot t-shirt with uniform bottoms and socks of their choice.

FREE DRESS GUIDELINES

- ❖ Permitted garments shall have no holes worn through, slashes or rips
- ❖ Bare midriffs, off the shoulder, or bare backs are not permitted
- ❖ Tank top straps must be a minimum of 1 ½ inches wide
- ❖ Spaghetti straps are not allowed
- ❖ Garments must be of appropriate length, cut and/or fit to meet these requirements while sitting and/or bending
- ❖ Shorts and skirts must be of modest length defined as a maximum of 6" above the knee of the wearer or not above the fingertip of the wearer with the arm fully extended, whichever is longer
- ❖ Dyed or streaked hair outside of natural colors is prohibited
- ❖ Shoes must be closed-toe shoes.



GUIDELINES FOR UNIFORM NONCOMPLIANCE

- ❖ First Time - Student will be sent to the office, non-compliance recorded and policy sent home with student for parent/guardian signature.
- ❖ Second Time - Student will be sent to the office, non-compliance recorded, policy sent home with student for parent/guardian signature.
- ❖ Third Time - Student will be sent to the office, non-compliance recorded and parent/guardian will receive notification of loss of privilege.
- ❖ After three uniform non-compliance issues, student will lose a Spirit and/or Free Dress Day. This includes sock/tights issues.

DRESSCODE OVERVIEW:

- Red, navy, white or purple polo or oxford uniform shirts or polo dresses
- Khaki or navy pants, skirts, shorts, jumpers, or dresses of appropriate length
- All socks or tights should be solid uniform colors or black with no logos.
- There should be no logos on any part of the uniform larger than a quarter.
- All sweaters should be solid uniform colors for indoor wear.
- Shoes need to be closed-toed
- Coats should remain in lockers.
