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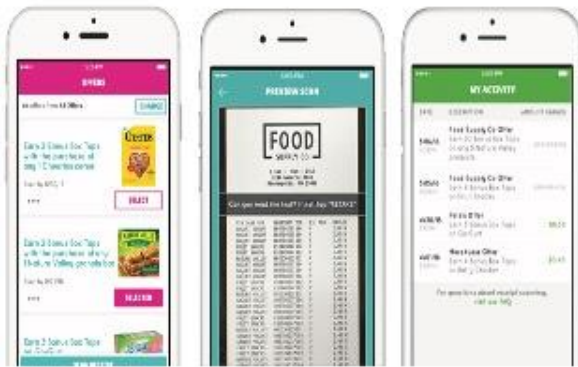

# Eliot **BOBCAT'S** **RUNNING AND** **BICYCLE CLUB'S**



We will be holding a 16 week 1st Semester Running Club on the Eliot track every Tuesday and Thursday weather permitting starting August 30th and ending December 20th. The 12 week 2nd Semester running club starts February 28th and ends May 18th. Start time is 7:00 a.m. to 7:20 a.m.

The Bicycle Club will have a ride once a month on the 2nd Sunday in September, October, November, March, April, May weather permitting. We will meet at Riverparks on the east side 21st & Riverside next to the Blue Rose Café at 2:00 p.m.

### **Running Club Procedures:**

1. Students will be on the track running/jogging/walking the entire 20 minutes.
2. Students must check in with Mr. Journey or parent monitor upon arrival at 7:00 a.m..
3. Students will be expected to go to their lockers and be on time for their first call after running before school.
4. Students participating will be on their best behavior at all times.

# WORKOUT WEDNESDAYS

Eliot is a Certified Safe and Healthy School. In alignment with the philosophy of healthy bodies grow healthy brains, we are now implementing Workout Wednesdays when students may wear athletic wear to school.



## Workout Wednesday Wear FAQs

- What kind of shirts can we wear?

Any shirt is allowed, including sports jerseys, spirit wear, team shirts, workout shirts, t-shirts, etc. Tank tops are allowed if straps are a minimum of 1 ½ inches wide. No spaghetti straps. TPS guidelines say “the cut of sleeveless garments must not expose undergarments or be otherwise immodest.”
- What kind of bottoms can we wear?

Any athletic pants, shorts, skirts, loose jeans or sweatpants are allowed. Leggings or tights can be worn if shorts or skirts of any length are worn over them. Shorts without anything underneath must match modesty guidelines. TPS guidelines say “tights or leggings worn as outerwear, spandex, bike shorts, bathing/swimming wear, sleep wear (including pajamas), etc., are not permitted. Shorts and skirts must be of modest length defined as a maximum of 6” above the knee of the wearer or not above the fingertip of the wearer with the arm fully extended, whichever is longer.”
- What about yoga pants?

Yoga pants or other stretchy, tight pants may be worn if a long shirt covers the posterior.
- Students always have the option to wear their uniform, as these are designed to facilitate the school day.
