SAFTEY INFORMATION

Family members,

What if?...

Do you know what to do in the event of a school crisis? As you know, safety is a priority at Eliot and we would like to take a moment to let you know what your role as a parent would be in a crisis situation. The entire staff works hard every day to ensure the safety of your student. In the event of a lock down of any type, the doors will not be opened to anyone outside the building, including parents. This also means if you are inside the building you will need to remain here to prevent any accidental entry.

Emergency responders have access to the building and will not need our assistance to open a locked door. So if there is any threat outside we want to keep students safe inside. When the threat passes we will open the doors.

If there is an event at our site that causes us to evacuate we will relocate to Brookside Baptist where our building crisis team will be able to provide information. We practice safety drills with students on a regular basis so that they know what to do should the need arise. It will be important for you to understand, even if we know you, we will not open doors to allow entrance. The safety of our children will always be a priority. Thank you for continuing the support of our school and the educational experience of your children.

So in summary:


- Wait for information

WORKOUT WEDNESDAYS

Eliot is a Certified Safe and Healthy School. In alignment with the philosophy of healthy bodies grow healthy brains, we are now implementing Workout Wednesdays when students may wear athletic wear to school.



Workout Wednesday Wear FAQs

What kind of shirts can we wear?

Any shirt is allowed, including sports jerseys, spirit wear, team shirts, workout shirts, t-shirts, etc. Tank tops are allowed if straps are a minimum of 1 ½ inches wide. No spaghetti straps. TPS guidelines say "the cut of sleeveless garments must not expose undergarments or be otherwise immodest."

What kind of bottoms can we wear?

Any athletic pants, shorts, skirts, loose jeans or sweatpants are allowed. Leggings or tights can be worn if shorts or skirts of any length are worn over them. Shorts without anything underneath must match modesty guidelines. TPS guidelines say "tights or leggings worn as outerwear, spandex, bike shorts, bathing/swimming wear, sleep wear (including pajamas), etc., are not permitted. Shorts and skirts must be of modest length defined as a maximum of 6" above the knee of the wearer or not above the fingertip of the wearer with the arm fully extended, whichever is longer."

What about yoga pants?

Yoga pants or other stretchy, tight pants may be worn if a long shirt covers the posterior.

O Students always have the option to wear their uniform, as these are designed to facilitate the school day.
